

Evacuation Diagrams & AS3745-2010 – Summary

Evacuation diagrams shall be displayed in all facilities.

Evacuation diagrams shall be displayed in locations where occupants and visitors are able to view the diagrams.

Evacuation diagrams shall have the correct orientation with regard to the direction of egress and its location to the "YOU ARE HERE" point.

The following shall be included in each evacuation diagram:

- A pictorial representation of the floor plan or area, which shall be at least 200 x 150mm.
- The title 'EVACUATION DIAGRAM'.
- The 'YOU ARE HERE' location.
- The designated exits in the facility shall be green.
- Warden intercommunication points (WIPs) and Manual call points (MCPs) shall be red and emergency call points (ECP's) shall be coloured white or have a black border.
- Hose reels, hydrants and fire blankets shall be red.
- Fire indicator panel (FIP), if provided.
- Extinguishers shall be red with an appropriate colour as per AS/NZ1841.1
- Validity date.
- Location of assembly area(s), either stated in words or pictorially represented.
- A legend, which shall reflect the symbols used.

Please note that points in the boxes are not relevant for FDC.
